House Jasmine Pearls



One of our best selling teas returns! Our House Jasmine Pearls uses the delicate leaf buds of the tea plant to produce this aromatic tea. The leaves are hand rolled into the little pearls then scented with jasmine blossoms. It takes about a week to produce a batch of this tea, alternating between scenting overnight and firing lightly in the morning, resulting in a perfect balance between the floral aromatics of the jasmine and the mild sweetness of the white tea buds.

House Roasted Taiwan Oolong



We chose our house teas to best represent the major tea categories and this time we found a Taiwanese oolong to represent the Oolong teas! Oolong might have originated in Fujian province in China but when the Fukienese people moved to Taiwan they took their teas and tea plants with them. Taiwanese roasted oolongs are just as full bodied as their Chinese counter-part. This oolong with floral and nutty aromatics harmonizes perfectly with the tastes of toasted almonds and a lingering fruity quality.

This city is known for its Dragon Well green tea but the Chinese have also appreciated the delicate white flowers from this region for centuries. Mild and sweet, this herbal infusion is reminiscent of chamomile, and like chamomile, contains no caffeine so it is perfect for enjoying before bed. Ideal hot brewed or cold brewed with a little honey.
